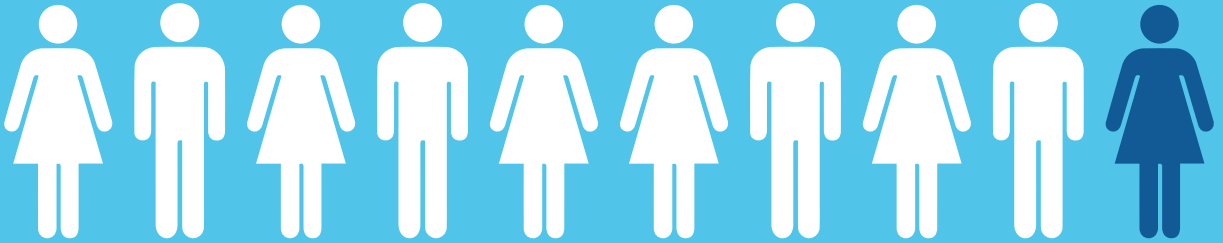

If you are between the ages 50 and 74, talk to your family doctor or nurse practitioner about getting checked for colon cancer with the fecal immunochemical test (FIT).

FIT is a free at-home test for eligible Ontarians

- FIT is safe and painless
- It only takes a few minutes to do
- You only need to collect one stool sample
- No need to change your diet or medications while you do your test
